1 Introduction

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

2 Types of Cookies that we may Use

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Cookie	Name	Purpose
Google Analytics	_utma _utmb _utmc _utmz	<p>These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the website, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited.</p> <p>Full details of the cookies we use for analytics can be found at Cookies & Google Analytics in documentation for Google's Analytics tracking code. Snap Surveys	_ga _utma _utmb _utmc _utmz	<p>CFP uses Snap Webhost to manage and host our online surveys. Snap WebHost uses cookies to signify previous responses to some types of surveys. These cookies do not collect or store personal data.</p> <p>More information is available here.</p>

If you already use these platforms their cookies may be set through our website. Flash Cookies		<p>Flash Cookies are employed by Adobe Flash Player to deliver video content playback features and for saving preferences. They are stored in a similar way to standard cookies. The Adobe website provides information on how to manage Flash cookies.</p>

Most Internet browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can set your browser to refuse cookies or show you when a cookie is set. If you choose to refuse cookies, some features of the website may not work correctly.
